Dear Members of the Grady Elementary Community,

I hope you and your family have enjoyed this year at Grady Elementary. I hope that your children have advanced academically, gained further understanding of other points of view and enhanced their relationships with their family, teachers and friends this year. I hope that the fifth graders who will be leaving Grady at the end of this year will carry the goodwill and empathy that is the trademark of our school out into the world.

This has been a busy and successful year full of blessings. We have fundraised for ambitious projects. We've raised in excess of \$30,000 this year and have spent or pledged to spend all of it on academic materials, academic tutoring and the perimeter fence. The first phase of the perimeter fence is being bid upon and a vendor will soon be selected. We are hopeful that we will soon be able to commence building the first phase of the project.

It is your generosity that makes such ambitious goals possible. We are grateful to you for your hard work and donations. This year, volunteers spent 1,500 more hours at Grady than during the same period last year – an increase of 37%. Sponsorship funds are also up substantially and the Spring walk-a-thon fundraiser made \$8,500 more than last year. Perhaps it is because we've had clear, attainable goals, or perhaps we have a wonderful and special group of members, volunteers and donors. Either way, I recognize exactly how blessed and lucky we are to have such fantastic parent, grandparent and teacher involvement in our events.

We have several more large-scale events before the year is over. Teacher Appreciation Week, May 5-9, is our opportunity to recognize and appreciate the hard work of Grady's teachers, staff, administration, custodians and cafeteria teams. I hope you will take part in our big thank you to the people who help prepare our children to lead wholesome and worthwhile lives.


