From PTA President, Damaris Allen

Dear Members of the Grady Elementary Community,

Thus far, our PTA has enjoyed a wonderful fall semester. Since my last letter to all of you, we've hosted a Mom's Night Out, two Family Nights at PDQ, a uniform exchange during conference night, two homeroom parents meetings and we partnered with Grady Elementary to present the Fall Festival.

We hope that you and your family had fun at the Fall Festival. There were a variety of games and activities, bounce houses and a photo booth at the festival. The Fall Festival required an enormous effort from our teachers, administrators, homeroom parents and parent volunteers. Thank you to each of you for your hard work, which greatly benefits the students at our school. Financially, the Fall Festival was a huge success because it raised about \$5,000 for our school.

We also completed a very successful Fall Fundraiser, which raised in excess of \$10,000 for our school. We are so proud of the hard work everyone has been doing to help raise funds for our school.

Since my last letter to you, the PTA has funded additional educational enhancements for our school. In October and November, the PTA funded the following amounts in mini-grants for educational enhancements: (1) \$475 for the purchase of the First in Math Program for the second grade; (2) \$275 for the registration costs for a teacher and assistant teacher to attend a speech pathology conference; (3) \$1,000 for audio books for the Kindergarten, first and second grades; (4) \$270 for purchase of the Starfall Math and Reading online program for the Kindergarten and first grade; (5) \$240 for the purchase of books for Battle of the Books for the fourth grade; (6) approved the purchase of 3 iPads for the ASD Program; (7) \$450 toward the ASD Program's weekly student project expenses. These expenditures are in addition to the \$6,000 we spent toward Common Core materials and the funds devoted to September mini-grants. We hope that Grady Elementary students will enjoy these educational enhancements paid for by your contributions of time and money.

Ranger Cookies



Ranger cookies take time to prepare, but they are distinctive, delicious cookies. This recipe **makes 8 dozen cookies** – perfect for a holiday cookie exchange.

Ingredients:

2 cups flour
1 cup brown sugar
1 cup sugar
1/2 tsp. baking powder
1 tsp. baking soda
1/2 tsp. salt
2 cups oatmeal
1 cup butter (softened)
2 eggs (beaten)
1 tsp. vanilla
2 cups chopped walnuts

2 cups shredded coconut

1 1/2 cups chocolate chips

Directions:

- 1. Mix the flour, brown sugar, sugar, baking powder, baking soda and salt in a large mixing bowl.
- 2. Mix the butter, eggs and vanilla in a small bowl. Add the buttery batter to the flour mix that is already in the large mixing bowl.
- 3. Add the oatmeal, walnuts, coconut and chocolate chips to the batter in the large mixing bowl. Mix it all up and spoon onto ungreased cookie sheets.
- 4. Bake each sheet at 350 degrees for approximately 12 minutes.

The Fifty Dollar Cookie



This cookie gets its nickname because it tastes like it should cost \$50.

Ingredients

2 sticks (1 cup) of butter softened

3/4 cup packed, of light brown sugar

- 1 cup of sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 1 tablespoon of vanilla extract
- 3 ½ cups of all purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon of salt
- 1 teaspoon of baking soda
- 1 10 oz bag of chocolate chips
- 1 regular size package of Oreo cookies

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. Cream butter and sugars together with a mixer until well combined. Beat in eggs and vanilla.
- 3. In a separate bowl, mix the flour, salt and baking soda. Slowly add to wet ingredients along with chocolate chips until just combined.
- 4. Using a cookie scoop or large spoon, take one scoop of cookie dough and place on top of an Oreo cookie, take another scoop of dough and place on the bottom of the Oreo cookie. Seal the edges together by pressing and cupping in hand until Oreo cookie is enclosed with dough.
- 5. Place cookies onto a parchment or silpat lined baking sheet, very far apart (these cookies expand). Bake each sheet of cookies 9-13 minutes or until golden brown. Let cool for 5 minutes before transferring to cooling rack.
